## Mod\_rewrite and Mod\_ORT

ORT (Ovh Redirect Technology) is a module developed by OVH which permits the hosting of numerous important sites with less RAM used by the systems.

Mod\_ort modifies the URI of the page and you may encounter a problem if you wish to use mod\_rewrite. The solution consists of redefining the root rewrite of mod\_rewrite:

```
RewriteRule ^/grp([0-9]+).php$ group.php?id=$1 [L]
RewriteRule ^/art([0-9]+).php$ article.php?id=$1 [L]
RewriteRule ^/age([0-9]+).php$ agenda.php?id=$1 [L]
RewriteRule ^/member_([0-9]+).php$ member.php?id=$1 [L]
```

need to be changed to:

```
RewriteRule ^/grp([0-9]+).php$ /group.php?id=$1 [L]
RewriteRule ^/art([0-9]+).php$ /article.php?id=$1 [L]
RewriteRule ^/age([0-9]+).php$ /agenda.php?id=$1 [L]
RewriteRule ^/member_([0-9]+).php$ /member.php?id=$1 [L]
```
